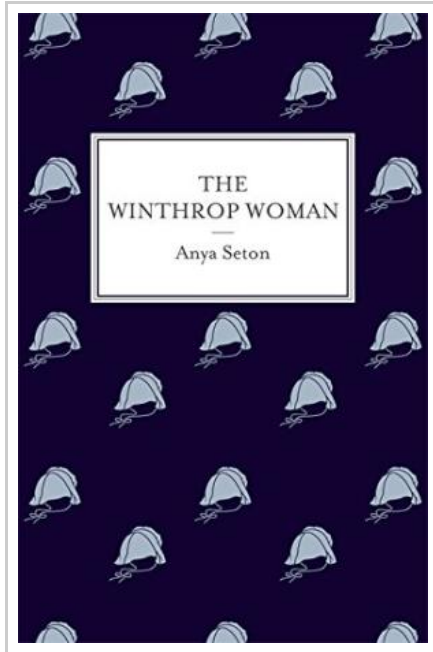




The Winthrop Woman
