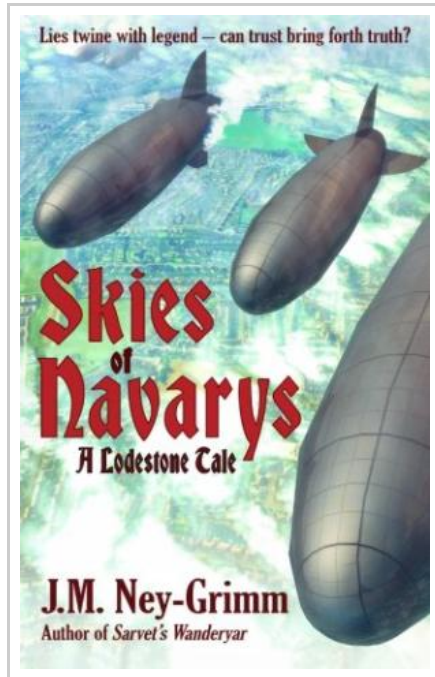




Skies of Navarys
